Board of Canvass Meeting Minutes March 9, 2021

The Board of Canvass was held on Tuesday, March 9, 2021, at the Canosia Town Hall. The town board chair called the meeting to order at 8:12 p.m.

The clerk administered the Board of Canvass oath to all three supervisors and presented them with the election Summary Statement and Board of Canvass Certification Form, copies of which will be attached to meeting minutes. There were 92 total votes: 84 for Penny Dieryck and 8 for Jim Gilmore.

The number of voted ballots matched the number of signatures/absentee (AB) designations on the roster. There were eight accepted absentee ballots. Penny Dieryck won the office of supervisor for a three-year term.

<u>Declare Results</u>: Motion by Comnick, seconded by Golen, to accept the results of the votes, declare Dieryck the winner and sign off on the Board of Canvass Certification Form. Motion carried unanimously via roll call vote (Brooks: aye, Comnick: aye, Golen: aye).

<u>Notification</u>: Motion by Golen, seconded by Comnick, authorizing the clerk to notify the candidates and request their signed campaign financial forms. Motion carried unanimously, 3-0 via roll call vote (Brooks: aye, Comnick: aye, Golen: aye).

The board thanked the election judges for all their hard work.

Adjourn: Motion by Brooks, seconded by Comnick, to adjourn the meeting at 8:19 p.m. Motion carried unanimously via roll call vote (Brooks: aye, Comnick: aye, Golen: aye).
