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### BUDGET MEETING MINUTES

February 2, 2022

ATTENDING: Chair Dan Golen, Supervisor Kevin Connick, Supervisor Penny Dieryck, Clerk Amber Madoll, Treasurer Cheryl Borndal, and Fire Chief Gene Stevens. The meeting was held in person at the Canosia Town Hall and virtually due to the pandemic.


Chair Golen called the meeting to order at 5:58 p.m.

- A. **2022 Budget Review**: Golen stated that the budget looked similar to the previous year. He asked if the Treasurer had any suggestions for changes and she stated no. Connick stated that while there were no recommended changes this year for roads, the snowplowing expenses continue to increase and there may need to be an increase next year. He also stated that he does not believe that there needs to be an increase in levy. The state recommends that townships keep a 6-8 month budget surplus. He stated that the township currently has a two year surplus. There was a discussion concerning the \$2,500 allotted to WLSSD for the PLAWCS sewer system. Connick stated that there are some budget expenses that were supported by CARE funds, and now by ARPA. As those funds run out, there may need to be an adjustment to the budget in future years if additional funding isn't secured. Treasurer Borndal asked for the board to pass a resolution at their next meeting to authorize that the current ARPA funds received can be allocated to the general fund. She stated that there was a draft resolution available through MAT. Clerk Madoll will work on Resolution 2022-1 and provide a draft to the board for review. Golen asked if any adjustments were needed to the Recreation Area, Recycling, etc. Connick stated that the AIS grant for 30K was approved.
- B. **Motion** made by Kevin Connick, seconded by Penny Dieryck to approve the 2022 \$297,200 annual budget as proposed and to not increase the 2023 Levy. Motion carried unanimously, 3 – 0.

### ADJOURNMENT

Motion by Penny Dieryck, seconded by Kevin Connick, to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 p.m. Motion carried unanimously, 3 – 0.


