December 3, 2025

Chair Cornick called the meeting to order at 4:59 p.m. and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. PLANNING AND ZONING:** None.
- B. FIRE RELIEF:** Chief Stevens stated that he would turn in the resolution to the state.
- C. FIRE DEPARTMENT:**
 - a.** Chief Stevens shared his report and stated that they prepared the trucks for the winter, that they sent a crew to Grand Lake for a structure fire burn, and that they have a night with a car extrication and patient rescue training.
 - b. Motion** made by Kevin Cornick, seconded by Penny Dieryck to approve Resolution 2025-19, which accepts donations for the fire department. Motion carried unanimously, 3-0. Kevin Cornick, Penny Dieryck, and Jeff Erikson voted in favor.

- c. Chief Stevens stated that they are working on purchasing equipment for the FEMA grant, that their annual Christmas gathering will be on the 13th at 5pm, and that their calendars are currently being printed for their fire relief fundraiser. He also stated that they are going to need to upgrade their radios in the next year.

- L. **WEBSITE:** Clerk Madoll stated that the website change over to .gov is still in process.


NEW BUSINESS
